Filming requirements

- Do not film any guests, as they are paying guests on a private island. Guests must not be disrupted, if guests are using the filming location wait for them to leave, do not ask them to relocate or film any crowded areas
- Do not film hotels or private homes on Hamilton Island
- Noise must be kept to a minimum
- Avoid shooting on Hamilton Island during low tide
- No permanent structures or structures which damage property may be set up
- All safety and road rules must be adhered to while filming. Equipment must be kept to a minimum and should not obstruct any walkways or access points
- Filming permission is granted on the basis final edit of vision and stills are sent to the permit issuer for approval before use. Approval will not be withheld unreasonably.

*Drone filming requires the operator has appropriate permissions and works in accordance with licence, CASA and HIE operation requirements.
