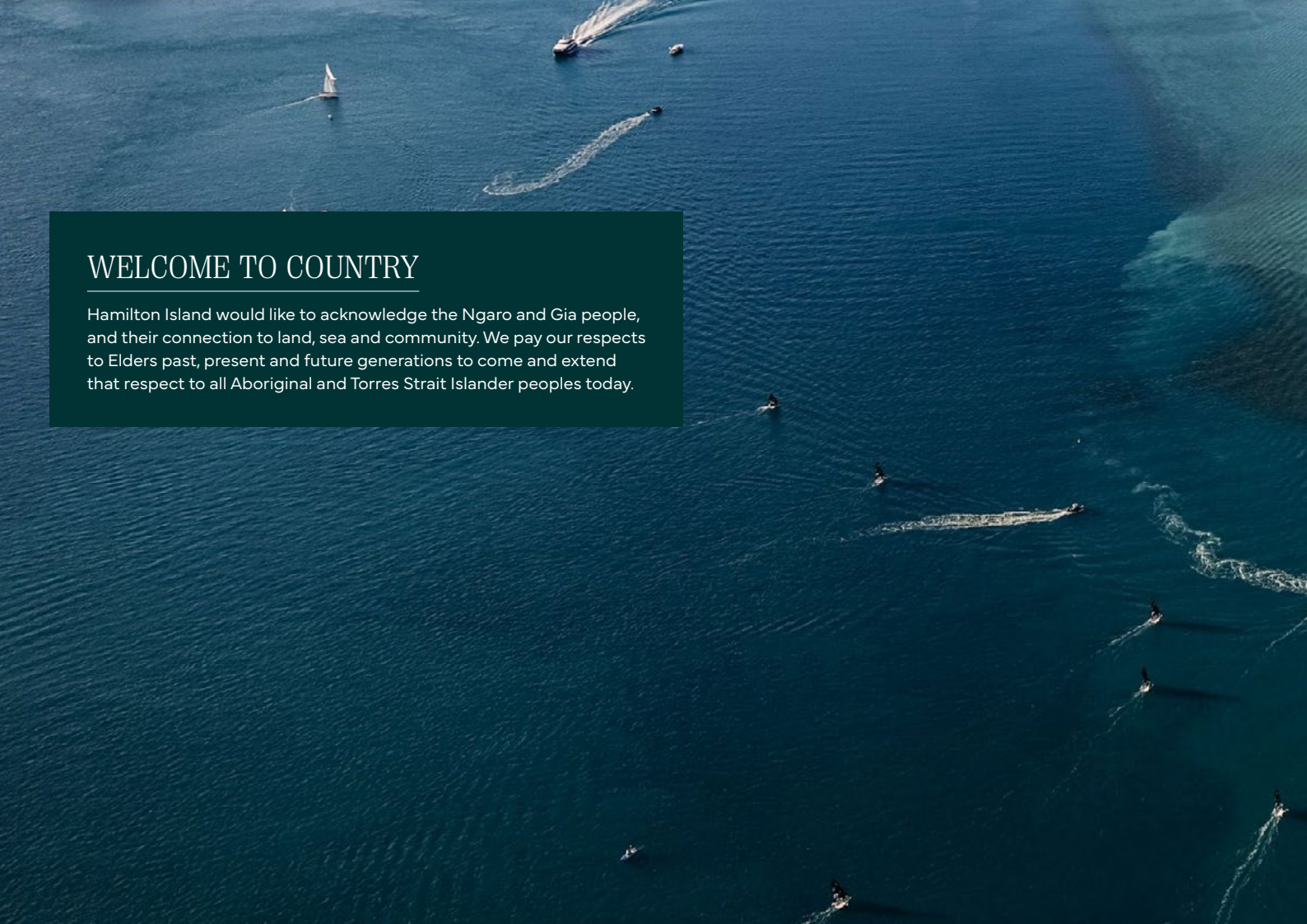

STAYING SAFE DURING RACE WEEK

Hamilton Island is best enjoyed safely. If you're travelling by buggy, please remember that Queensland road rules apply across the island. Buggies are licensed to carry a maximum of four passengers, seatbelts must be worn by all occupants and driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited.

With increased activity across the island during Race Week, please take extra care around pedestrians and shared roads, particularly in busy areas such as Front Street and the Marina Village.

To help everyone enjoy Race Week responsibly, additional Island Shuttle services will operate throughout the event, providing a convenient alternative to driving. Shuttles depart regularly from the stop outside the Hamilton Island Ice Cream Parlour on Front Street, making it easy to get back to your accommodation after an afternoon or evening out.

Queensland Police Service officers will also be present on the island throughout Race Week to support the safety and wellbeing of all guests and ensure Queensland road rules are observed.

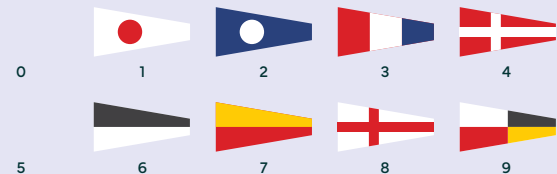

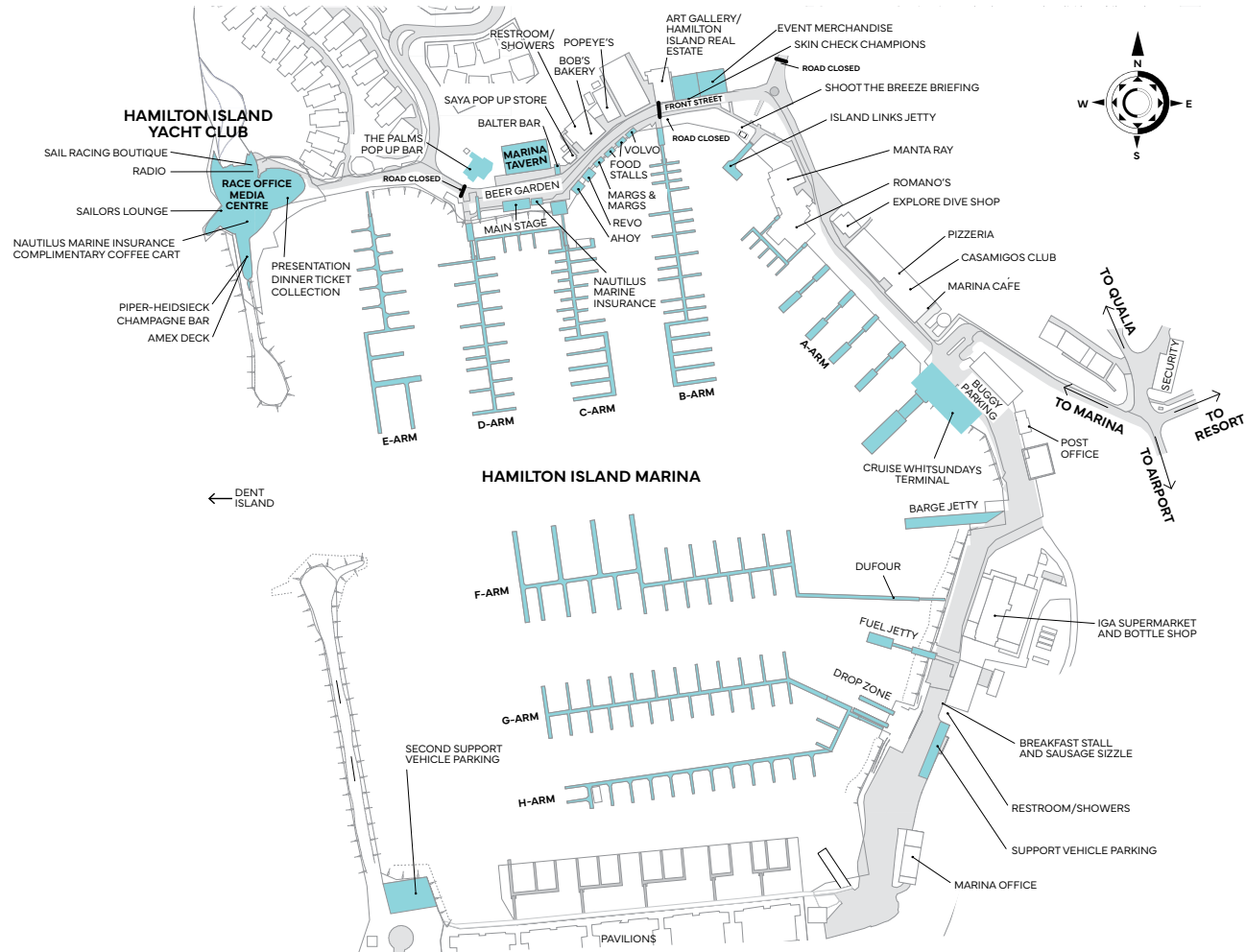

Banking

Hamilton Island is a cashless environment, and we are unable to accept cash at any of our outlets. Cash deposits and withdrawals can be made using the Bank@Post service at the Australia Post office on Front Street, where cash can also be exchanged for pre-paid or top-up Mastercards.

A non-refundable 1.25% surcharge (inclusive of any applicable Sunday and Public Holiday surcharge) applies for all 'credit' and 'tap and go' transactions made via credit or debit card. Fee free payments can be made via EFTPOS upon your request to our staff. Once requested, please insert your card and select 'savings' or 'cheque'.

Babysitting

Boat Equipment

The Chandlery will be open 8.00am - 5.00pm daily, offering a wide variety of equipment for all boats.

Bottle Shop

The bottle shop is located in the IGA Supermarket complex and open 10.00am - 9.00pm Monday - Friday and 10.00am - 7.00pm Saturday - Sunday.

Buggy Hire

Buggy Hire is available on an hourly, full day or overnight basis. A full drivers licence is required (minimum driver age 21yrs). For bookings please visit the Hamilton Island website or App, or make your way to Resort Buggy Hire near Spa wumurdaylin. A reminder that Hamilton Island buggies are registered Queensland vehicles and normal road rules apply, including no drink driving and wearing a seatbelt at all times. No buggy may be driven on Hamilton Island between 1.00am - 4.00am; penalties apply.

Dress Standard

Smart casual dress after 6.00pm. Singlets and thongs are not appropriate attire in restaurants or bars.

Equipment Movement

The Marina Office will be present in the harbour each morning; they will have vessels available to assist you with equipment transfers. You cannot book this service, simply flag them down.

Gym

The HI Fitness Club is located adjacent to the Reef View Hotel and is open from 6.00am - 6.00pm Monday - Friday, 9.00am - 1.00pm Saturday. 24 Hour Access passes are available. Use of the facilities is free for guests staying at qualia, Beach Club, Reef View Hotel and Palm Bungalows. The facilities are also accessible for all other guests – visit the HI Fitness Club to purchase a day pass.

IGA Supermarket

Hamilton Island's IGA supermarket is located in the marina offering fresh fruit and vegetables, meats, deli produce and more. Open during Race Week from 7.00am - 9.00pm Weekdays, 7.00am - 7.00pm Saturday and 8.00am - 6.00pm Sunday.

Parking

As part of Hamilton Island's commitment to protecting the Great Barrier Reef and its wildlife, we kindly ask all Prix d'Elegance entrants **not to use balloons as part of their boat decorations.**

Once released or lost overboard, balloons and their ribbons can travel long distances and pose a serious threat to marine life, particularly turtles, seabirds and other wildlife that may mistake them for food or become entangled in them.

We encourage competitors to get creative with reusable, recyclable and environmentally responsible decorations that help make the Prix d'Elegance spectacular while protecting the beautiful environment that makes Hamilton Island Race Week so special.

Thank you for helping us keep our island and surrounding waters clean and safe for future generations.

SKIN CHECK CHAMPIONS

A visit to the Skin Check Champions clinic has become an integral part of Hamilton Island Race Week. For more than a decade, this service has provided thousands of competitors and guests with potentially life-saving skin checks.

What began as a handful of nurses and a borrowed marquee has, with the long-standing support of Hamilton Island and the vision of the Oatley family, evolved into one of Australia's most advanced pop-up skin check clinics. Today, the clinic combines certified nurse dermoscopists and a specialist skin cancer GP with AI-assisted imaging technology trusted by leading dermatologists worldwide.

The impact has been extraordinary. Skin Check Champions has screened close to 8,000 people at Hamilton Island Race Week, identifying hundreds of melanomas and well over 1,000 basal cell carcinomas (BCCs) and squamous cell carcinomas (SCCs). For many, it has been their very first skin check.

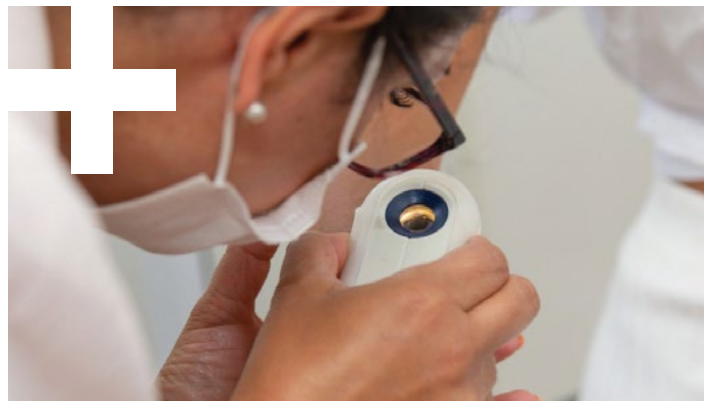
According to the Cancer Council, skin cancer is Australia's most common cancer. The good news is that the vast majority of skin cancers can be successfully treated when detected early.

Whether you've spent the day racing or relaxing ashore, take 15 minutes to visit the complimentary Skin Check Champions clinic, located upstairs at the Hamilton Island College. It could be the most important appointment of your Race Week.

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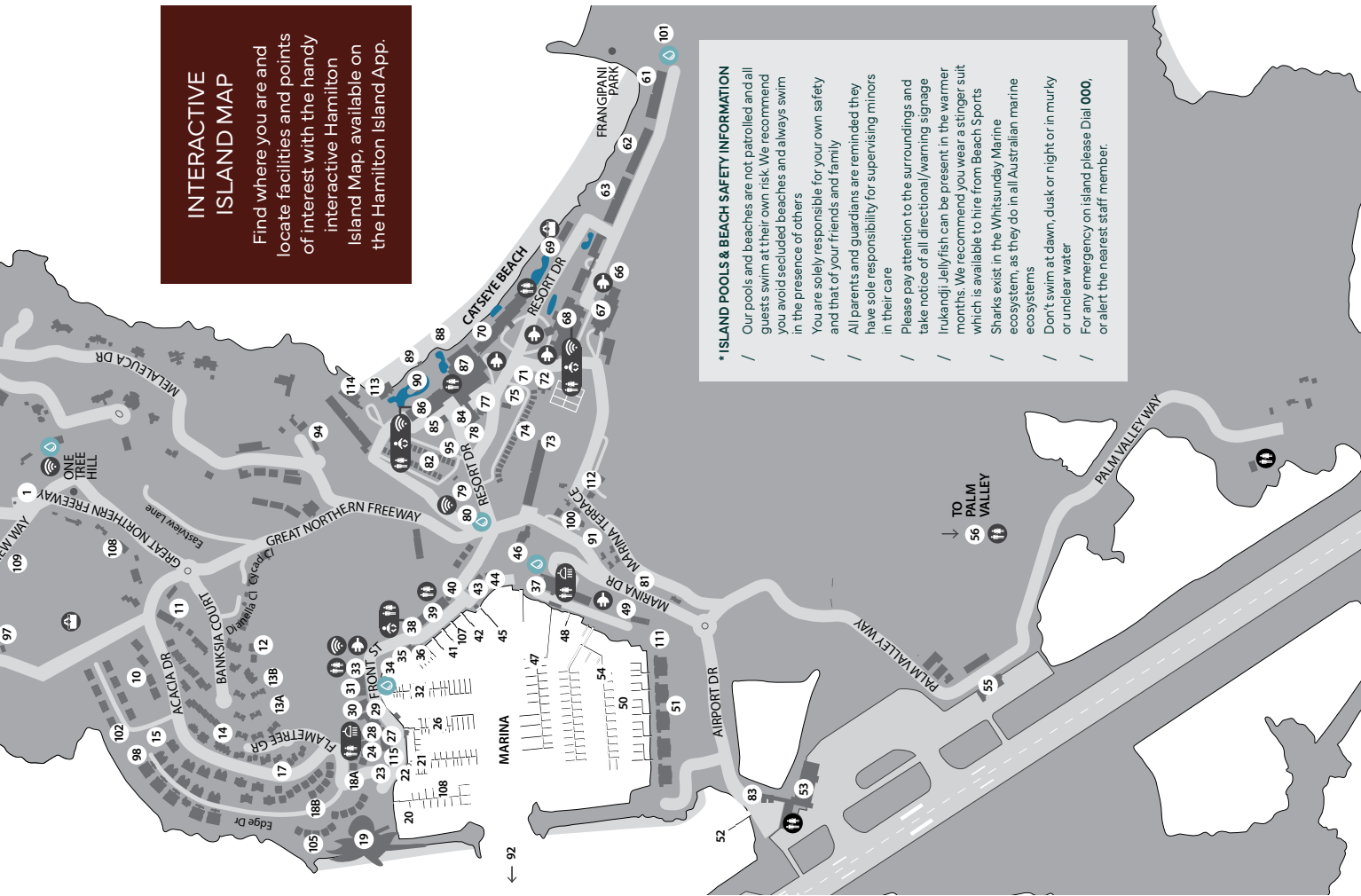
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
